The Silverdale Community and Economic Development Committee is embarking on a new project to improve Silverdale's park systems and is seeking your thoughts and input to apply for a \$250,000 State grant.

The Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program Grant supports planning, implementation and equipment and is sponsored by the PA Department of Community and Economic Development. We can use this grant to revitalize Silverdale's two community parks, the Al Reese Park at Borough Hall and the newly created Silver Street Park coming in 2026.


Al Reese Park is a three acre site and is actively used by residents on a daily basis. The park currently has a basketball court, two tennis/pickle ball courts, a tot playground, park benches, picnic tables, barbecue grills, swing sets, slides and a pavilion. The Borough has cleared out brush in the back of the Park, opening up roughly one acre of additional space for community use.

In 2026, Silver Street Park will evolve into a passive 3-acre community park. The initial creation of will include a walking trail, parking spaces and storm water improvements. This new park is completely funded by new Developer Impact Fees, benefiting the entire community.
